ADA Eligibility Appeal Procedures

Any denied applicant has 60 days from the date of their denial letter to file an appeal. There is an official appeal form. It will be reviewed and a decision will be rendered within 20 days from receipt of the appeal. SRA will contact the applicant upon the decision. If a decision is not made within 20 days of receipt of the completed appeal form, transportation will be provided unless a decision to deny the appeal is issued.

Applicants that have been denied a second time have 60 days from the date of the determination to file a written appeal with the Eligibility Appeals Committee. Applicants may receive an in-person interview if desired, but must be requested in the appeal. If noted, SRA will contact them to schedule a meeting. The appeal will be reviewed and a decision will be rendered within 20 days from receipt of the appeal. If a decision is not made within 20 days of receipt of the completed appeal form, transportation will be provided unless a decision to deny the appeal is issued. If the committee upholds the original determination:

Applicants may make a final appeal, notify SRA in writing within 10 days of receipt of their letter, and SRA will contact them with a final decision. If a decision is not made within 10 days of receipt of the appeal, transportation will be provided unless a final decision to deny the appeal is issued.
